

Jennifer Wexton said “I’m not looking to increase anybody’s taxes”:

Wexton bragged about the state of the economy under Joe Biden, called it a success, and said “we’ve had a very big economic growth during the pandemic.”:

- **ANCHOR:** “There’s been a lot of spending that’s been going on during the course of this pandemic. Are Democrats ready to tackle what the President wants to do here which is start cutting the deficit?”
 - **WEXTON:** “Absolutely we are. And thankfully, we’ve had a very big economic growth during the pandemic. - **ANCHOR:** “Guilty on all counts. 7News has learned that a Loudoun County juvenal judge found quote sufficient evidence to convict a fifteen-year-old for sexually assaulting a girl in a bathroom at Stone Bridge High School on May 28th. The fifteen-year-old now facing charges in a separate sexual assault from October and the judge will sentence him once that case is wrapped up. The case sparked national attention thanks to this picture. That’s the girl’s father, Scott Smith, being arrested at a Loudoun School board meeting. He says he went there because the Board would not listen to his complaints about the assault against his daughter.
