Streety Is Currently Imprisoned On Four Human Trafficking Convictions For Offenses Occurring After 2017

In July 2026, Streety Was Sentenced On Charges Including Human Trafficking Involving Commercial Sexual Activity, Human Trafficking Involving Subjecting A Person To Forced Labor, And Human Trafficking Enterprise Resulting In Injury Or Commercial Sexual Activity. “According to a news release by the Macomb County Prosecutor’s Office, Streety was ordered to serve 7-20 years for human trafficking involving subjecting a person to forced labor, 7-15 years for human trafficking involving commercial sexual activity, and 7-15 years human trafficking enterprise resulting in injury or commercial sexual activity. ... He also must complete serving a sentence for a human-trafficking conviction involving sex that resulted in injury for which he was sentenced in January 2019 to three years in prison. He was paroled in May 2022 and was to be on parole until next month.” (“Detroiters sentenced to prison for Warren human-trafficking, prostitution charges,” [Macomb Daily](#), 7/6/26)

Streety Was Also Required To Complete His Sentence For His 2019 Human Trafficking Conviction After Violating His Probation. “He also must complete serving a sentence for a human-trafficking conviction involving sex that resulted in injury for which he was sentenced in January 2019 to three years in prison. He was paroled in May 2022 and was to be on parole until next month.” (“Detroiters sentenced to prison for Warren human-trafficking, prostitution charges,” [Macomb Daily](#), 7/6/26)

- **In 2023, Streety Forced A Woman To Perform Sex Acts On Men In Exchange For Money.** “A Detroit man has been sentenced to prison for human trafficking again after he and another man forced a woman to perform sex acts with other men in exchange for money in 2023.” (Melissa Frick, “Repeat human trafficker from Detroit sentenced to prison again,” [MLive](#), 7/7/26)

In 2019, Streety Was Sentenced To Between Three And 15 Years In Prison For Human Trafficking. “This is the second time Streety is being sent to prison for human trafficking. In 2019, he was sentenced to three to 15 years behind bars for one count of human trafficking - forced labor causing commercial sex. In that case, Streety was arrested after a victim escaped from a Southfield hotel while under Streety’s control.” (Melissa Frick, “Repeat human trafficker from Detroit sentenced to prison again,” [MLive](#), 7/7/26)

- **Streety Was Charged In May 2018.** “Streety was sentenced last Thursday in Oakland County Circuit Court before Judge Phyllis McMillen.
