In December 2023, House Majority PAC Placed \$3.7 Million On TV Ads And \$1.5 Million On Digital Ads Supporting Tom Suozzi For Congress. “The Democratic-aligned House Majority PAC is putting down \$5.2 million in initial reservations for TV and digital ads to try to win the House special election to replace the expelled Rep. George Santos, R-N.Y., the group told NBC News. The group said it will spend \$3.7 million on TV and \$1.5 million on digital platforms, along with \$700,000 on mail ads, in the weeks ahead of the Feb. 13 contest in New York’s 3rd Congressional District. Build Back Better Would Increase Personal And Business Taxes. “The House passed the \$1.75 trillion Build Back Better Act on November 19, 2021, and the legislation is now under Senate consideration. Known as H.R. 5376, the legislation is the second prong of President Biden’s social and economic policy program. 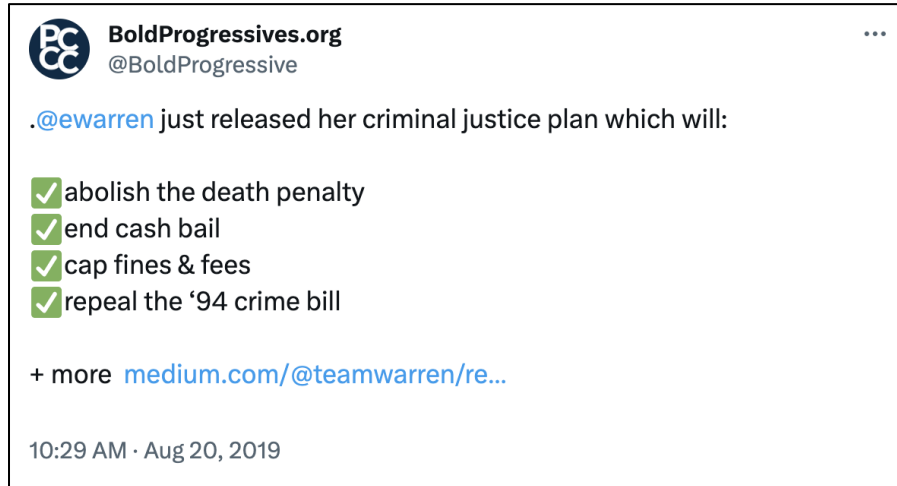

In 2018 And 2019, Soros-Funded California Justice And Public Safety PAC Supported Liberal District Attorney Candidates Including George Gascon And Chesa Boudin. “A political action committee with a majority of its funding from billionaire investor George Soros has contributed more than \$1 million to Diana Becton's campaign for Contra Costa County District Attorney. Earlier this month, county election filings showed an independent expenditure of just over \$400,000 from the California Justice & Public Safety PAC. On May 28, the PAC spent an additional \$540,000-plus. ... Becton is a progressive prosecutor who was elected in 2018 on a platform of criminal justice system reform. A member of the ‘Prosecutor’s Alliance,’ Becton has aligned herself with other progressive California DAs Chesa Boudin of San Francisco, George Gascon of Los Angeles, and Tori Verber Salazar of San Joaquin. Justice And Public Safety PAC Spent Almost \$1.7 Million To Support Larry Krasner For Philadelphia District Attorney. “Soros, a billionaire philanthropist interested in criminal justice reform, had already spent about \$10 million to back progressive candidates for top prosecutor jobs in 2017 when he turned his attention to Philadelphia. His team spoke to potential district attorney candidates, including Bradford-Grey, before backing Krasner.
