

In Her Congressional Campaign, Altman Has Claimed To Support Restoration Of The SALT Deduction

In 2023, Altman Said Restoring The SALT Deduction Was “Non-Negotiable” For Her And A Key Policy She Would Pursue To Make Her District More Affordable For Constituents. HOST: “If elected to Congress, how would you make your district more affordable to live in?” ALTMAN: “Yeah, that's a great question. Um, so the SALT deduction has to come back, has to be restored. That was taken away because Trump wanted to show the blue states who the boss was, and it's really hurt New Jersey's homeowners in a very high-tax state. And so folks are feeling the pain of that, because they made financial decisions. I was at a coffee roundtable this morning, where people were talking about this, and they made financial decisions to move to certain parts of the state because they thought that we get that deduction and not getting that deduction really hurts them financially. 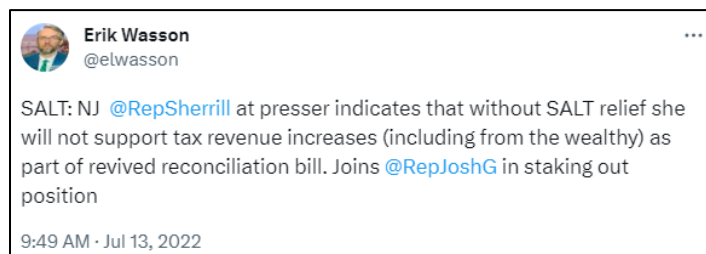

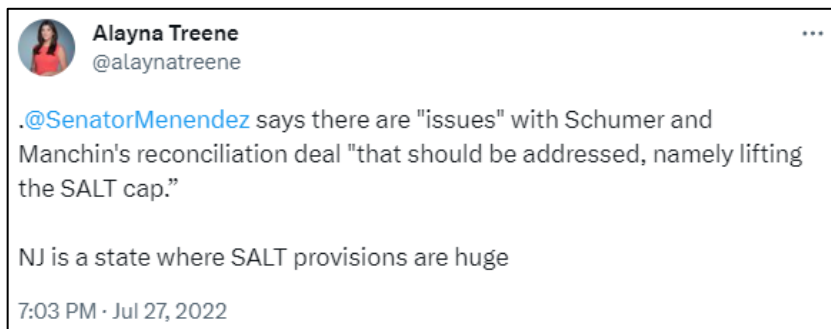
