### **Voting Rights For Illegal Immigrants**

#### **In 2023 And 2024, Deluzio Voted To Allow Illegal Immigrants In Washington, D.C. To Vote In Elections**

**On February 9, 2023, Deluzio Voted Against A Bill Repealing Washington, D.C. Legislation Allowing Noncitizens And Illegal Immigrants To Vote In Washington, D.C. Elections.** “Passage of the joint resolution that would establish congressional disapproval of, effectively repealing, the November 2022 District of Columbia Council legislation allowing noncitizens, including undocumented immigrants, to vote in local D.C. elections beginning in 2024.” (HJ Res 24, Roll Call 118, Passed 260-162, 2/9/23, Deluzio Voted Nay; CQ Summary, Accessed 1/16/24)

- **42 Democrats Voted With Republicans To Pass The Resolution.** “The first resolution took aim at D.C.’s Local Resident Voting Rights Amendment Act, which allows noncitizen residents to vote in local elections. The D.C. Council approved the measure in October. But on Thursday, the House voted to disapprove the bill in a 260-162 vote. Despite Democratic Whip Katherine Clark (D-Mass.) urging members of her caucus to vote ‘no,’ 42 Democrats joined with their Republicans colleagues in support.” (Michael Schnell, “House Passes Resolutions To Block Noncitizen Voting Bill, Criminal Code,” [The Hill](#), 2/9/23)

**On May 23, 2024, Chris Deluzio Voted Against Allowing Noncitizens To Vote In Local D.C.
