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HF 489 Increased The Waiting Period Before A Sex Offender Can Ask A Court To Reduce Their Registry Requirements. “A period of time has elapsed since the date of the offender’s initial registration as follows: (1) (a) Except as otherwise provided in subparagraph division (b), a tier I offender initially registered at least ten years prior to the filing of the application. (b) A tier I offender who was under twenty years of age at the time the offender committed a violation of section 709.4, subsection 1, paragraph “b”, subparagraph (3), subparagraph division (d), initially registered at least five years prior to the filing of the application. (2) A tier II or tier III offender initially registered at least twenty-five years prior to the filing of the application.” ([HF 489](#), Iowa Legislature, Passed House 84-12)
