

STATEMENT

Cait Conley opposes allowing local homeowners to deduct up to \$40,000 of state and local taxes on their federal tax return. Under Conley's plan, the average middle-class family or senior citizen in the Hudson Valley would have seen their taxes go up by an average of \$4,000 this year, in addition to other rising costs.

The OBBB Raised The SALT Cap From \$10,000 To \$40,000 For Taxpayers Making Less Than \$500,000 A Year. “Negotiations between House and Senate Republicans broke through to address the state and local tax (SALT) deduction and the Senate adopted the House approach to raise the SALT cap from \$10,000 to \$40,000 for taxpayers earning less than \$500,000 for five years before returning to the \$10,000 cap. This had been a major sticking point for moderate House Republicans from New York and New Jersey. Further, the OBBB does not include limits on the corporate SALT (C-SALT) deduction and does not include limitations on the SALT pass-through entity tax (PTET) workarounds.” (Lisa M.
