Despite claiming to fight for lowering utility costs, Josh Riley is supported by organizations that advocated for the laws that increased utility rates, has accepted thousands from utility lobbyists, and owns more than \$100,000 in stocks for the parent company of NYSEG – the company responsible for raising upstate New York utility rates.

In July 2025, NYSEG Filed A New Proposal Which Could Lead To Increased Prices For Ratepayers. "On July 1, NYSEG filed its proposal for its 'Powering New York' plan with the Department of Public Services. The multi-billion-dollar billion-dollar plan focuses on rebuilding and expanding the state's aging power grid. The plan will be in part subsidized by a possible ten percent increase on roughly thirty-five percent of your NYSEG bill that the company directly controls." The Climate Leadership And Community Protection Act (CLCPA), Introduced As Bill S6599, Was Signed By Governor Cuomo In July 2019. “In the final days of session, The Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act (S6599/A8429) passed the state senate. An August 2023 Report Found That The Cost Of The CLCPA “Will Cost New Yorkers Far More Than Advertised.” “Simply put, the vast majority of spending lies ahead of us over the next several decades, so the report indirectly suggests that CLCPA policies will cost New Yorkers far more than advertised. That appears to be the case even if other elements of CLCPA do not face 100 percent cost overruns, as has development of the Port of Albany’s wind turbine [sic] production facility. Unfortunately, it is the nature of huge government projects to come in vastly overbudget, and CLCPA projects are unlikely to be an exception to the rule.” (James E. NYSEG Announced The “Powering NY” Plan, Which Will Increase Utility Rates For Customers, To Achieve The Climate Goals Set By The CLCPA

In July 2025, NYSEG Announced The “Powering NY” Plan That Will Be Funded By Increasing Rates For Electric And Gas Customers. “Binghamton residents may soon face higher utility bills under a new plan proposed by New York State Electric and Gas. An Environmental Policy Expert And Adjunct Fellow Of A Think Tank Said That There Is A Connection Between The CLCPA And NYSEG’s Rate Increase Plan

In A July 2025 Op-Ed, Roger Caiazza Said That “There Is A Connection” Between The CLCPA “Recently Announced New York State Electric And Gas Rate Case Increase Plan.” “There is a connection between the Climate Leadership and Community Protection Act and the recently announced New York State Electric and Gas rate case increase plan. I don’t think we can afford to implement the CLCPA. The NYSEG rate case includes a proposed increase in annual electric revenues of approximately \$464.4 million... This would result in a typical residential bill increase of \$33.12 per month (a 23.7 percent increase to the total bill) for a customer using 600 kWh per month. The requested revenue increases due to CLCPA policy programs are 26 percent of the monthly increase, or \$8.52. This is just a portion of the electricity cost increases caused by the Climate Act. 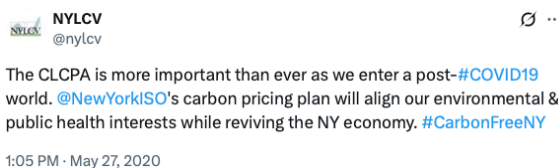

In November 2024, Riley Ran On The WFP Line. “Members of New York’s Working Families Party and the United Auto Workers union rallied in Ithaca on Sunday, making final pleas to voters just days before the election.
