Servers, Nurses, And Truck Drivers All Are Eligible To Receive Overtime Or Tipped Pay

Servers In Restaurants Benefit From Tipped Wages. “In a fullservice restaurant, servers, customers, and restaurant owners all benefit from the tip wage. Nurses Are Eligible For Overtime Pay. “Registered nurses who are paid on an hourly basis should receive overtime pay. Truck Drivers That Are Employed By A Company Are Required To Be Paid Overtime For Time Worked In Excess of 40 Hours Per Week. “The Fair Labor Standards Act (“FLSA”) is the federal law that governs the payment of wages. The FLSA requires employees to be paid at least the federal minimum wage for all hours worked, and it requires employees to be paid overtime for all hours worked in excess of 40 per workweek.
